• typed, double spaced, 12 pt. font. (Students may turn in handwritten papers with special permission from the teacher.)

• Sources: You must get your information from at least two different sources, internet or otherwise, to write this paper. Wikipedia is okay for one source. Answers.com and other answer-sites are not.

*Due date:* One week from now.

## **Grading Rubric**

**100-90:** (1) My paper covers all topics listed in description, (2) is longer than a page, (3) is neat, and has few to no spelling, grammar or punctuation errors, (4) and tells about the 2 or more sources where I got my information.

**89-80**: My paper has any three of the above four.

**79-70:** My paper has any two of the above four.

**69-60:** My paper has any one of the above four.

**59-0:** My paper has nothing to do with the assignment.
